


### KDOL: UI Fraud Summary as of 12/07/20




- Thousands of false unemployment insurance claims were made in the names of unknowing employees due to identity theft
  - As of December 7, 2020:
    - KDOL reported more than 157,000 TOTAL fraudulent claims/attempts
    - KDOL reports they were stopping 2,300+ DAILY fraudulent claims/attempts



The F8I advises the public to be on the lookout for the following suspicious activities: • Recovery and the R8I advises the public to be on the lookout for the following suspicious activities: • Receiving communications regarding unemployment insurance forms when you have not applied for unemployment benefits • In a submitted transactions on bank/credit card statements related to unemployment benefits • In the R8I advises the submitted for qualifying for unemployment insurance • Unsolicited inquiries related to unemployment benefits • Fictifitous websites and social media pages mimicking those of government agencies • Requests for bank information • Surveys 2. Never give out personal information over email or text message; don't open/respond to unsolicited messages 3. Don't wire money, and always ignore the following requests: • Communications related to your Ul benefits from someone asking for money • Someone who says they can help you file for your benefits for a fee, and • Anyone claiming to work for K700U whos gas they need a fee to complete your application • Offers from people/organizations you don't recognize promising early/flaster Ul benefit payments Anyone claiming to work for K700U was gustual address, statements demanding action right away, emails asking for personal information or bank account information • Never give out your personal information information on websites or social media channels, especially those that claim they can help you apply for Ul benefits • Third parties cannot apply for your benefits
