## **HOW A BILL BECOMES A LAW**

In Kansas, a bill in may be introduced in either The House of Representatives (125 members) or the Senate (40 members), and will follow the below process to becoming a law:

## **HOUSE OF ORIGIN**

- 1. Bill Introduced
- 2. Bill Referred to Committee for Hearings/Deliberation/Approval (may include Amendments)
- 3. House of Origin
- 4. House of Origin Committee of the Whole: Deliberation/Approval (may include Amendments)
- 5. House of Origin Vote for Final Passage
- 6. Bill messaged to the Second House
