

HOW A BILL BECOMES A LAW

In Kansas, a bill may be introduced in either The House of Representatives (125 members) or the Senate (40 members), and will follow the below process to becoming a law:

HOUSE OF ORIGIN

1. Bill Introduced
2. Bill Referred to Committee for Hearings/Deliberation/Approval (may include Amendments)
3. House of Origin
4. House of Origin - Committee of the Whole: Deliberation/Approval (may include Amendments)
5. House of Origin Vote for Final Passage
6. Bill messaged to the Second House
